## CLE CREDIT

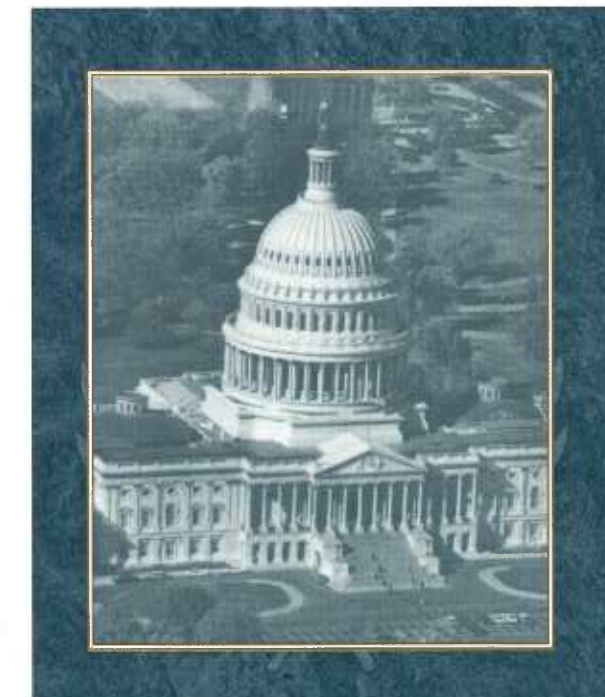
